PRESENT WEATHER:

At 3:00 PM today, a Low Pressure Area (LPA) was estimated based on all available data at 895 km East Northeast of Basco, Batanes (22.2°N, 130.4°E). Meanwhile, another LPA was estimated based on all available data at 280 km West of Iba, Zambales (15.0°N, 117.4°E). Southwest Monsoon affecting Central and Southern Luzon and Western Visayas.
