PRESENT WEATHER:

At 3:00 PM today, the center of Severe Tropical Storm "QUEDAN" was estimated based on all available data at 1,105 KM East of Aparri, Cagayan (18.4N, 132.1E) with maximum sustained winds of 90 KM/H near the center and gustiness of up to 115 KM/H. It is forecast to move North Northwest at 21 KM/H. Intertropical Convergence Zone (ITCZ) affecting Mindanao.
