PRESENT WEATHER:

Ridge of a High Pressure Area (HPA) affecting Visayas. Meanwhile, at 4:00 PM today, the center of a tropical depression outside the Philippine Area of Responsibility (PAR) was estimated based on all available data at 415 km west of Sinit, Ilocos Sur (17.5°N, 116.5°E) with maximum sustained winds of 55km/h near the center and gustiness of up to 65 km/h. It is forecast to move north northwest at 13km/h.

WATERCOURSES LIKELY TO BE AFFECTED	<u>Rivers and Tributaries in:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • PALAWAN - particularly Abongan, Lian, Barabakan, Rizal, Caramay, Langogan, Babuyan, Bacungan, Iwahig Penal, Inagauan, Aborlan, Malasgao, Apurauan, Baton-Baton, Aramayawan, Ihawig, Panitian, Pulot, Lamakan, Kinluga, Eraan, Tiga Plan, Malabangan, Ilog, Bansang, Conduaga, Culasian, Iwahig (Brookes), Okayan, Canipan and Busuanga, Coron. • ORIENTAL MINDORO - particularly Malaylay-Baco, Pulang Tubig, Mag-asawang Tubig, Butas, Pula, Agsalin, Bansud, Samagui, Bongabon, Baroc, Bulalacao and Balete. • MARINDUQUE – particularly Tawiran-Tagum (Marinduque) and Boac. • OCCIDENTAL MINDORO - particularly Abra de Ilog, Caragay, Labangan, Magbando, Lunintao, Anahawin, Monpong, Amnay, Pola, Pagbahan, Mamburao and Ibod.
