AT 3:00 PM TODAY, THE CENTER OF TROPICAL DEPRESSION "INDAY" WAS ESTIMATED BASED ON ALL AVAILABLE DATA AT **755 KM** EAST OF BASCO, BATANES (**19.0 °N, 129.0 °E**) WITH MAXIMUM SUSTAINED WINDS OF **60 KM/H** NEAR THE CENTER AND GUSTINESS OF UP TO 75 KM/H MOVING EAST AT 25KM/H. SOUTHWEST MONSOON AFFECTING LUZON

WATERCOURSES LIKELY TO BE AFFECTED	<p>Rivers and Tributaries in:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Cavite particularly Laboc (Balsahan), Cañas, Ilang-ilang and Imus • Rizal particularly Upper Marikina and Kaliwa • Batangas particularly in Lian, Banabang-Molino, Pansipit, Kapumpang, Rosario-Lobo and Upper Bolbok (Lawaya). • Quezon particularly in Upper Umiray, Lower Bolbok (Lawaya), Malaking-Ilog, Iyam, Macalelon, Catanauan, Silongin Lagda, Pagsanjan, Yabahaan, Bigol, Guinhalinan, Vinas, Calauag, Pandanan, Sta. Lucia, Lugan Malaybalay, Maapon, Bucal (Lalangan), Lakayat, Tignoan, Agos, Anibawan (Polilio Island) and Upper Kilbay – Catabangan • Laguna particularly Pagsanhan, Pila-Sta.Cruz, San Juan, and San Cristobal.

WATERCOURSES LIKELY TO BE AFFECTED	<u>Rivers and Tributaries in:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Antique particularly Sibalom, Ipayo, Cagaranan, Palawan, Cairauan, Dalanas and Tibiao.• Aklan particularly Ibajay, Aklan and Jalo.• Iloilo particularly in Pinantan, Barotac, Akalaygan, Jalaud, Jalano, Jagdong, Jalaur, Lamunan, Jaro-Agaman, Sibalom and Guimbal.• Negros Occidental particularly Malogo, Sicaba, Grande, Himocaan, Danao, Upper Tyabanan, Sipalay and Lower Ilog• Capiz particularly Panay, Mambusao, Panay Malinao, Alingon and Balantian
