



PRESENT WEATHER:

At 3:00 AM Today, the center of tropical depression "HENRY" was estimated based on all available data at 75 km West – Southwest of Calayan, Cagayan (19.1 N, 120.8 E) with maximum sustained winds of 60 KM/H near the center and gustiness of up to 75 KM/H. Moving West at 20 KM/H. Meanwhile, the Low Pressure Area (LPA) was estimated at 825 KM East of Infanta, Quezon (15.4 N, 129.3 E). Southwest Monsoon affecting the country.

No. 3 for Region I (Ilocos Region)

No. 2 for Region II (Cagayan Valley)

FORECAST 12-HR RAINFALL	Light to moderate to at times heavy rains.
WATERCOURSES STILL LIKELY TO BE AFFECTED	Rivers and Tributaries in: <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Isabela particularly Dikatayan, Dinilican, and Palanan-Pinacanauan• Cagayan particularly Linao, Lower Abulug, Lower Pamplona, Cabcungan, Aunugay, Baua, Palawaig, and Taboan.

No. 19 for Region III (Central Luzon)

FORECAST 12-HR RAINFALL	Moderate to occasionally heavy rains.
WATERCOURSES STILL LIKELY TO BE AFFECTED	<u>Rivers and Tributaries in:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Bataan particularly Balanga, and Moron • Zambales particularly Panatawan, Sto. Tomas, Bucau, Bancul, and Lawis • Bulacan – all rivers and its tributaries

No. 8 for Region IV-A (CALABARZON)

FORECAST 12-HR RAINFALL	Light to moderate rains.
WATERCOURSES STILL LIKELY TO BE AFFECTED	<u>Rivers and Tributaries in:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Cavite particularly Laboc (Balsahan), Cañas, Ilang-ilang and Imus • Rizal particularly Upper Marikina and Kaliwa • Batangas particularly in Lian, Banabang-Molino, Pansipit, Kapumpang, Rosario-Lobo and Upper Bolbok (Lawaya). • Quezon particularly in Upper Umiray, Lower Bolbok (Lawaya), Malaking-Ilog, Iyam, Macalelon, Catanauan, Silongin Lagda, Pagsanjan, Yabahaan, Bigol, Guinhalinan, Vinas, Calauag, Pandanan, Sta. Lucia, Lugan Malaybalay, Maapon, Bucal (Lalangan), Lakayat, Tignoan, Agos, Anibawan (Polilio Island) and Upper Kilbay – Catabangan • Laguna particularly Pagsanhan, Pila-Sta.Cruz, San Juan, and San Cristobal.

No. 19 for Region IV-B (MIMAROPA)

FORECAST 12-HR RAINFALL	Moderate to occasionally heavy rains.
WATERCOURSES STILL LIKELY TO BE AFFECTED	<u>Rivers and Tributaries in:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Oriental Mindoro particularly Malaylay-Baco, Pulang Tubig, Mag-asawang Tubig, Butas, Pula, Agsalin, BAnsud, Samagui, Bongabon, Baroc, Bulalacao, and Balete. • Palawan particularly Abongan, Lian, Barabakan, Rizal, Caramay, Langogan, Babuyan, Bacungan, Iwahig Penal, Inagauan, Aborlan, Malasgao, Apurauan, Baton-baton, Aramayawan, Ihawig, Panitian, Pulot, Lamakan, Kinlугan, Eraan, Tiga Plan, Malabangan, Ilog, Bansang, Conduaga, Culasian, Iwahig (Brookes), Okayan, Canipan and Busuanga, Coron. • Occidental Mindoro particularly in Abra de Ilog, Cagaray, Labangan, Magbando, Lunintao, Anahawin, Monpong, Amnay, Pola, Pagbahan, Mamburao, and Ibod.

No. 4 for Region VI (Western Visayas)

FORECAST 12-HR RAINFALL	Light to occasionally moderate rains.
WATERCOURSES STILL LIKELY TO BE AFFECTED	<u>Rivers and Tributaries in:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Antique particularly Sibalom, Ipayo, Cagaranan, Palawan, Cairauan, Dalanas and Tibiao. • Aklan particularly Ibajay, Aklan and Jalo. • Iloilo particularly in Pinantan, Barotac, Akalaygan, Jalaud, Jalano, Jagdong, Jalaur, Lamunan, Jaro-Agaman, Sibalom and Guimbal. • Negros Occidental particularly Malogo, Sicaba, Grande, Himocaan, Danao, Upper Tyabanan, Sipalay and Lower Ilog • Capiz particularly Panay, Mambusao, Panay Malinao, Alingon and Balantian

No. 2 for Cordillera Administrative Region

FORECAST 12-HR RAINFALL	Light to moderate to at times heavy rains.
WATERCOURSES STILL LIKELY TO BE AFFECTED	<u>Rivers and Tributaries in:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Abra particularly Upper Abra, Tineg, Ikmin.• Ifugao – all rivers and its tributaries.• Apayao particularly Upper Abulug.• Mountain Province – all rivers and its tributaries• Kalinga – all rivers and its tributaries• Benguet particularly Upper Bauang

People living near the mountains slopes and in the low lying areas of the above-mentioned river systems and the local **Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Councils** concerned are **still advised to take necessary precautionary measures.**
