PRESENT WEATHER:

At 3:00 AM today, the eye of Typhoon "Rosita" was located based on all available data at 550 km East of Tuguegarao City, Cagayan (17.4°N, 126.9°E). with maximum sustained winds of up to 170 km/h near the center and gustiness of up to 210 km/h. It is moving west southwest at 15 km/h.

WATERCOURSES LIKELY TO BE AFFECTED	 Rivers and Tributaries in: Isabela – particularly Dikatayan, Dinilican and Palanan-Pinacanauan. Cagayan – particularly Linao, Lower Abulug, Lower Pamplona, Cabicungan, Aunugay, Baua, Palawaig, and Taboan.

FORECAST 12-HR RAINFALL	Light to moderate rains
WATERCOURSES	Rivers and Tributaries in:
LIKELY TO BE AFFECTED	Aurora – particularly Casiguran, Aguang, and Lower Umiray.
