PRESENT WEATHER:

At 3:00 PM today, the center of **Severe Tropical Storm "LIWAYWAY" (LINGLING)** was estimated based on all available data at **205 km East of Basco, Batanes (20.8°N, 123.9°E)** with maximum sustained winds of **110 km/h** near the center and gustiness of up to **135 km/h**. It is moving North Northwest at **15 km/h**. Southwest Monsoon affecting Luzon and Western Visayas.
