PRESENT WEATHER:

Northeast monsoon affecting Northern Luzon. Tail-end of a cold front affecting the eastern section of Central and Southern Luzon.

FORECAST RAINFALL:

Cloudy skies with scattered rainshowers and thunderstorms.

WATERCOURSES **NO LONGER TO BE AFFECTED:**

- **TAGUM-LIBUGANON RIVER** and its tributaries particularly Tuganay, Saug and Simong Rivers.

With this event and unless significant rain occurs, this is the final general flood advisory for this event.

PUBLIC WARNINGS:

People living near the mountain slopes and in the low lying areas of the above mentioned river systems and the local disaster risk reduction and management councils (LDRRMCs) concerned are advised to be on alert for possible/further flashfloods and landslides and to take necessary precautionary measures.
