At 3:00AM Today, the center of Tropical Depression "GORIO" was estimated based on all available data at 440 km Northeast of Borongan City, Eastern Samar (14.5°N 128.2°E) with maximum sustained winds of 60 kph near the center and gustiness of up to 75 kph. It is forecasted to move North Northwest at 15 kph. Southwest Monsoon affecting the Western Section of Luzon and Visayas.
