PRESENT WEATHER:

At 3:00 PM today, the center of Tropical Storm "MARING" was estimated based on all available data at 460 km West of Iba, Zambales (15.5°N, 115.7°E) with maximum sustained winds of 85 km/h near the center and gustiness of up to 105 km/h. It is forecast to move West Northwest at 18 km/h. Meanwhile, at 3:00 PM today, the eye of Typhoon "LANNIE" was located based on all available data at 635 km Northeast of Basco, Batanes (25.0°N, 125.7°E) with maximum sustained winds of 130 km/h near the center and gustiness of up to 160 km/h. It is forecast to move Northwest at 13 km/h.
