No. **06** for Region I (Ilocos Region)

No. 18 (FINAL) for Region IV-A (CALABARZON)

WATERCOURSES NO LONGER TO BE AFFECTED	<u>Rivers and Tributaries in:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • LAGUNA particularly Pagsanjan, Pila-Sta Cruz, San Juan and San Cristobal. • RIZAL particularly Upper Marikina and Kaliwa.
