#### No. **02** for Region III (Central Luzon)

<b>WATERCOURSES STILL LIKELY TO BE AFFECTED</b>	<u>Rivers and Tributaries in:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• <b>AURORA</b> – particularly Casiguran, Agung and Lower Umiray.</li></ul>

#### No. **01** for Region IV-A (CALABARZON)

<b>FORECAST 12-HR RAINFALL</b>	Light to moderate with at times heavy rains.
<b>WATERCOURSES LIKELY TO BE AFFECTED</b>	<u>Rivers and Tributaries in:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• <b>QUEZON</b> – particularly Upper Umiray, Lower Bolbok (Lawaya), Malaking-Ilog, Iyam, Macalelon, Catanauan, Silongin Lagda, Pagsanjan, Malaybalay, Maapon, Bucal (Lalangan), Lakayat, Tignoan, Agos, Anibawan (Polilio Island) and Upper Kilbay - Catabangan.</li><li>• <b>LAGUNA</b> – particularly Pagsanjan, Pila-Sta. Cruz, San Juan and San Cristobal.</li><li>• <b>RIZAL</b> – particularly Upper Marikina and Kaliwa.</li></ul>

<b>WATERCOURSES LIKELY TO BE AFFECTED</b>	<b><u>Rivers and Tributaries in:</u></b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• <b>CAMARINES SUR</b> – particularly <b>Lower Kilbay, Catabangan, Rigay, Tinalmud, Tambang and Lagonoy.</b></li><li>• <b>CAMARINES NORTE</b> – particularly <b>Labo and Daet Basud.</b></li><li>• <b>SORSOGON</b> – particularly <b>Lower Donsol, Ogod, Putiao, Cadacan, Banuang-Duan, Fabrica (Tugbugan) and Matnog.</b></li><li>• <b>CATANDUANES</b> – particularly <b>Cabuyan, Bato and Pajo.</b></li><li>• <b>ALBAY</b> – particularly <b>Guinale and Upper Donsol.</b></li></ul>
