**PRESENT WEATHER:**

At 3:00 AM today, the eye of Typhoon "RAMON" {KALMAEGI} was estimated based on all available data in the vicinity of **Gonzaga, Cagayan (18.2°N, 122.0°E)** with maximum sustained winds of **100 kph** near the eye and gustiness of up to 165 kph. It remains almost stationary. Furthermore, at 3:00 AM today, the center of Tropical Depression "SARAH" was estimated based on all available data at **530 km East Northeast of Virac, Catanduanes** or **780 km East of Infanta, Quezon (15.1 °N, 128.9 °E)**, with maximum sustained winds of **55 km/h** near the center and gustiness of up to 70 km/h. It is moving Northwest at 25 km/h.

People living near the mountain slopes and low-lying areas near the above-mentioned river systems and the Local Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Councils (LDRRMCs) concerned are **still advised to be alert for possible flashfloods and landslides.**
