PRESENT WEATHER:

Under present weather conditions, At 3:00 PM today, the center of **Tropical Storm "SARAH" {FUNG-WONG}** was estimated based on all available data at **555 km East Northeast of Casiguran, Aurora or 570 km East of Tuguegarao City, Cagayan (17.7 °N, 127.1 °E)**, with maximum sustained winds of 65 km/h near the center and gustiness of up to 80 km/h. It is moving North °Northwest at 30 km/h. Meanwhile, at 3:00 PM today, the **Low Pressure Area (LPA) (formerly "RAMON")** was estimated based on all available data in the vicinity of **Kayapa, Nueva Vizcaya (16.5 °N, 120.9 °E)**
