**PRESENT WEATHER:**

AT 3:00 AM TODAY, THE CENTER OF SEVERE TROPICAL STORM "SARAH" {FUNG-WONG} WAS ESTIMATED BASED ON ALL AVAILABLE DATA AT 420 KM EAST NORTHEAST OF APARRI, CAGAYAN OR **340 KM EAST OF BASCO, BATANES (20.1 °N, 125.2 °E)**, WITH MAXIMUM SUSTAINED WINDS OF 95 KM/H NEAR THE CENTER AND GUSTINESS OF UP TO **115 KM/H**. IT IS MOVING NORTH NORTHWEST AT **25 KM/H**. MEANWHILE, AT 3:00 AM TODAY, THE LOW PRESSURE AREA (LPA) (FORMERLY "RAMON") WAS ESTIMATED BASED ON ALL AVAILABLE DATA AT **55 KM WEST SOUTHWEST OF IBA, ZAMBALES (14.7 °N, 119.8 °E)**.

<b>WATERCOURSES LIKELY TO BE AFFECTED</b>	<u>Rivers and Tributaries in:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Apayao – upper Abulug.</li> <li>• Ifugao – all rivers and its tributaries.</li> <li>• Mountain Province - all rivers and its tributaries.</li> <li>• Abra – upper Abra, Tineg, and Ikmin.</li> <li>• Kalinga – all rivers and its tributaries</li> <li>• Benguet – upper Bauang</li> </ul>

People living near the mountain slopes and low-lying areas near the above-mentioned river systems and the Local Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Councils (LDRRMCs) concerned are **still advised to be alert for possible flashfloods and landslides.**
