At 3:00 AM today, the center of Severe Tropical Depression "EMONG" was estimated based on all available data at 540 km North Northeast of Basco, Batanes (24.9°N, 124.0°E) with maximum sustained winds of 90 kph near the center and gustiness of up to 115 kph. It is forecast to move North Northwest at 30 kph.
