**PRESENT WEATHER:**

At **3:00 PM** today, the eye of Typhoon "PAOLO" was located based on all available data at **840 km** East of **Basco, Batanes (19.8°N, 130.0°E)** with maximum sustained winds of 145 km/h near the center and gustiness of up to 180 km/h. It is forecast to move North Northeast at 17 km/h. Meanwhile, the Low Pressure Area (LPA) estimated south of Mindoro has dissipated.
