PRESENT WEATHER:

Tail-end of a Cold Front affecting the Eastern section of Northern and of Central Luzon. Intertropical Convergence Zone (ITCZ) affecting Visayas and Mindanao. Northeast monsoon affecting extreme Northern Luzon. Issued 0500HRS 07 November 2017.
