### PRESENT WEATHER:

At **3:00 PM** today, the eye of Typhoon "PAOLO" was located based on all available data at **930 km East of Baler, Aurora (16.4°N, 130.2°E)** with maximum sustained winds of **130 km/h** near the center and gustiness of up to **160 km/h**. It is forecast to move North Northwest at **15 km/h**. Meanwhile, the Low Pressure Area (LPA) was estimated based on all available data at **175 km Northwest** of Puerto Princesa City, Palawan (**10.9°N, 117.7°E**).
