PRESENT WEATHER:

At 3:00 AM today, the eye of Typhoon "PAOLO" was located based on all available data at 895 km East of Daet, Camarines Norte (14.7°N, 131.2°E) with maximum sustained winds of 120 km/h near the center and gustiness of up to 145 km/h. It is forecast to move North Northwest at 15 km/h. Meanwhile, the Low Pressure Area (LPA) was estimated based on all available data at 185 km West of Puerto Princesa City, Palawan (9.5°N, 117.1°E).
