At 3:00 PM today, the center of Tropical Depression "Goring" was estimated based on all available data at 340 KM North Northeast of Basco, Batanes (23.4 °N, 122.9°E) with maximum sustained winds of 45 KM/H near the center and gustiness of up to 60 KM/H. It is moving Northeast at 30 KM/H. Southwest monsoon affecting Luzon.
