PRESENT WEATHER:

Southwest Monsoon Affecting the Western Section of Luzon. Meanwhile, at 3:00 PM today, the center of Tropical Depression Rumbia was estimated based on all available data at 1,010 KM North Northeast Of Extreme Northern Luzon (28.3 °N, 127.0°E) [Outside PAR] with Maximum Sustained Winds Of 60 Km/H Near the Center And Gustiness Of Up To 75 Km/H. It Is Moving North Northwest At 25 Km/H.

WATERCOURSES LIKELY TO BE AFFECTED	Rivers and Tributaries in: <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Bataan – particularly Balanga and Moron.• Zambales – particularly Panatawan, Sto Tomas, Bucau, Bancul, and Lawis.• Bulacan – all rivers and its tributaries.• Tarlac – all rivers and its tributaries.
