<b>WATERCOURSES STILL LIKELY TO BE AFFECTED</b>	<b><u>Rivers and Tributaries in:</u></b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• <b>Iloilo</b> – particularly Pinantan, Barotac, Aklaygan, Jalaud, Jalano, Jagdong, Jalaur, Lamunan, Jaro-Agaman, Sibalom and Guimbal</li><li>• <b>Negros Occidental-</b> particularly Malogo, Sicaba, Grande, Himocaan, Danao, Upper Tyabanan, Sipalay and Lower Ilog</li></ul>
