PRESENT WEATHER:

At 3:00 PM today, the center of Tropical Depression "TINO" was estimated based on all available data at 75 KM East Southeast of Puerto Princesa City, Palawan (9.6N 119.4E) with maximum sustain winds of up to 55 KM/H and gustiness of up to 90KM/H. It is forecast to move west northwest at 28 KM/H. Northeast monsoon affecting Northern Luzon.
