PRESENT WEATHER:

AT 3:00 PM TODAY, THE CENTER OF THE SEVERE TROPICAL STORM "AMBO" (VONGFONG) WAS ESTIMATED BASED ON ALL AVAILABLE DATA AT 30 KM NORTHEAST OF TAYABAS, QUEZON (14.2°N, 121.8 °E) WITH MAXIMUM SUSTAINED WINDS OF 100 KM/H NEAR THE CENTER AND GUSTINESS OF UP TO 140 KM/H. IT IS MOVING NORTHWESTWARD AT 20 KM/H.

In order to better inform/warn communities, you are reminded to disseminate these through local/community leaders and through your local media, including community radio stations. Conduct press briefings as often as needed. This local effort will complement and reinforce efforts at the national level. Emphasis should be on proactive actions – evacuation rather than rescue.

Moreover, you are hereby directed to reiterate the guidelines on personal protection and hygiene such as respiratory etiquette and hand hygiene, social distancing, environmental, and food safety measures.

Let's untiringly aim for zero casualty.
