PRESENT WEATHER:

AT 3:00 PM TODAY, THE EYE OF TYPHOON "AMBO" WAS LOCATED BASED ON ALL AVAILABLE DATA IN THE VICINITY OF CLAVERIA, MASBATE (12.8°N, 123.3 °E) WITH MAXIMUM SUSTAINED WINDS OF 125 KM/H NEAR THE CENTER AND GUSTINESS OF UP TO 165 KM/H. IT IS MOVING TOWARDS THE NORTHWESTWARD AT 15 KM/H.

People living near the mountains slopes and in the low-lying areas of the above-mentioned river systems and the **LOCAL DISASTER RISK REDUCTION AND MANAGEMENT COUNCILS** concerned are advised to be alert for possible flashfloods and landslides.


