PRESENT WEATHER:

At 4:00 AM today, the eye of Typhoon "LAWIN" was located based on all available data at 1,075 km east of Daet, Camarines Norte (14.6° N, 132.9°E) with maximum sustained winds of up to 185 kph near the center and gustiness of up to 230 kph. It is forecast to move west northwest at 24 kph.
