#### I. SITUATION OVERVIEW:

At 9:00 AM today, a **Low Pressure Area (LPA)** was estimated based on all available data at **390 km Southeast of Mindanao (4.5°N, 128.3°E)** (outside PAR). The trough of the LPA will bring **moderate to occasionally heavy rains and thunderstorms** over the Regions of Caraga, Davao and SOCCSKSARGEN. Residents in these areas are alerted against **possible flashfloods and landslides**. Residents in these areas are alerted against **possible flashfloods and landslides**. Meanwhile, **light to moderate rains and isolated thunderstorms** will prevail over the **rest of Mindanao**.

The public is advised to **continuously monitor** for updates.

#### II. ACTIONS TAKEN

- NDRRM Operations Center disseminated **Weather Advisory No. 01 for Low Pressure Area** to all OCD Regional Offices through SMS and facsimile and uploaded on the NDRRMC website for further dissemination to their respective local DRRMCs from the provincial down to the municipal levels.
  - Directed RDRRMCs concerned through the OCD Regional Offices to undertake precautionary measures in their areas of responsibility (AOR) and subsequently advised local DRRMCs to initiate pre-emptive evacuation of families in low-lying areas and mountainous areas if situations warrants.
