I. SITUATION OVERVIEW:

At 10:00 AM today, the **Low Pressure Area (LPA)** was estimated based on all available data at **815 km East of Hinatuan City, Surigao del Sur (7.9°N, 133.7°E)**. The trough of this Low Pressure Area (LPA) will bring light to moderate rains and isolated thunderstorms in Mindanao and the Regions of Eastern Visayas and Bicol.

This disturbance may develop into a Tropical Cyclone within the next 24 to 36 hours.

The public is advised to **continuously monitor** for updates.

II. ACTIONS TAKEN

- NDRRM Operations Center disseminated **Weather Advisory No. 01 for Low Pressure Area** to all OCD Regional Offices through SMS and facsimile and uploaded on the NDRRMC website for further dissemination to their respective local DRRMCs from the provincial down to the municipal levels.
- Directed RDRRMCs concerned through the OCD Regional Offices to undertake precautionary measures in their areas of responsibility (AOR) and subsequently advised local DRRMCs to initiate pre-emptive evacuation of families in low-lying areas and mountainous areas if situations warrants.
