




NDRRMC UPDATE

I. SITUATION OVERVIEW:

At 10:00 AM today, the **Low Pressure Area (LPA)** was estimated based on all available data at **635 km East of Juban, Sorsogon (13.3°N, 129.8°E)**. This LPA is no longer directly affecting any part of the country. However, the Eastern section of Luzon and of Visayas will experience cloudy skies with light rains due to Amihan.

With this development, this is the Final Advisory on the LPA.

II. ACTIONS TAKEN

- NDRRM Operations Center disseminated **Weather Advisory No. 02 (FINAL) for Low Pressure Area** to all OCD Regional Offices through SMS and facsimile and uploaded on the NDRRMC website for further dissemination to their respective local DRRMCs from the provincial down to the municipal levels.
- Directed RDRRMCs concerned through the OCD Regional Offices to undertake precautionary measures in their areas of responsibility (AOR) and subsequently advised local DRRMCs to initiate pre-emptive evacuation of families in low-lying areas and mountainous areas if situations warrants.
