**I. SITUATION OVERVIEW**


**Tropical Depression "BISING" has maintained its strength and is now moving in a North Northeast direction.**

	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Estimated rainfall amount is from moderate to occasionally heavy rains within the 300 km diameter.</li> <li>Sea travel is risky over the Eastern Seaboards of Southern Luzon, of Visayas, and of Mindanao.</li> </ul>
<b>Location of Eye/Center</b>	At <b>10:00 PM</b> today, the center of Tropical Depression "BISING" was estimated based on all available data at <b>470 km East Northeast of Hinatuan, Surigao del Sur (10.3 °N, 130.1 °E)</b> .
<b>Strength</b>	Maximum winds of up to <b>45 kph</b> near the center and gustiness of up to <b>55 kph</b> .
<b>Forecast Movement</b>	Forecast to move <b>North Northeast at 10 kph</b> .
<b>Forecast Positions</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>24 Hour (Tomorrow evening): <b>630 km East Northeast of Guiuan, Eastern Samar(12.5°N, 131.3°E)</b></li> <li>48 Hour (Tuesday evening): <b>770 km East Northeast of Guiuan, Eastern Samar(13.5°N, 132.3°E)</b></li> <li>72 Hour (Wednesday evening): <b>945 km East Northeast of Guiuan, Eastern Samar(12.8°N, 134.2°E)</b></li> <li>96 Hour (Thursday evening): <b>1,160 km East Northeast of Hinatuan, Surigao del Sur (OUTSIDE PAR)(11.8°N, 136.3°E)</b></li> </ul>
