#### I. SITUATION OVERVIEW

The Low Pressure Area East of Mindanao has developed into a Tropical Depression and was named "BISING".

	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Estimated rainfall amount is from moderate to occasionally heavy rains within the 300 km diameter of Tropical Depression (TD).</li> <li>Sea travel is risky over the Northern and Eastern Seaboards of Luzon and the Eastern Seaboard of Visayas.</li> </ul>
<b>Location of Eye/Center</b>	At 4:00 PM today, the center of Tropical Depression "BISING" was estimated based on all available data at 735 km East of Hinatuan, Surigao del Sur (8.0°N, 133.0°E).
<b>Strength</b>	Maximum winds of up to 45 kph near the center and gustiness of up to 55 kph.
<b>Forecast Movement</b>	Forecast to move West Northwest at 13 kph.
<b>Forecast Positions</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>24 Hour (Tomorrow afternoon): 460 km East of Hinatuan, Surigao del Sur (8.2°N, 130.5°E)</li> <li>48 Hour (Sunday afternoon): 340 km East of Guiuan, Eastern Samar (10.8°N, 128.8°E)</li> <li>72 Hour (Monday afternoon): 510 km East Northeast of Borongan City, Eastern Samar (13.9°N, 129.5°E)</li> <li>96 Hour (Tuesday afternoon): 895 km East Northeast of Borongan City, Eastern Samar (15.2°N, 132.8°E)</li> <li>120 Hour (Wednesday afternoon): 1,100 km East Northeast of Guiuan, Eastern Samar (OUTSIDE PAR) (14.2°N, 135.3°E)</li> </ul>

## II. ACTIONS TAKEN

- NDRRM Operations Center disseminated **Severe Weather Bulletin No. 01 for Tropical Depression "BISING"** to all OCD Regional Offices through SMS and facsimile and uploaded on the NDRRMC website for further dissemination to their respective local DRRMCs from the provincial down to the municipal levels.
  - Directed RDRRMCs concerned through the OCD Regional Offices to undertake precautionary measures in their areas of responsibility (AOR) and subsequently advised local DRRMCs to initiate pre-emptive evacuation of families in low-lying areas and mountainous areas if situations warrants.
