





**I. SITUATION OVERVIEW**

Tropical Depression "BISING" has maintained its speed as it continues to move in a North Northwest direction.

<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Estimated rainfall amount is from moderate to occasionally heavy rains within the 300 km.</li> <li>Sea travel is risky over the Eastern Seaboards of Southern Luzon, of Visayas, and of Mindanao.</li> </ul>	
<b>Location of Eye/Center</b>	At 10:00 AM today, the center of Tropical Depression "BISING" was estimated based on all available data at 400 km East of Surigao City, Surigao del Norte (9.8°N, 129.1°E).
<b>Strength</b>	Maximum winds of up to <b>45 kph</b> near the center and gustiness of up to <b>55 kph</b> .
<b>Forecast Movement</b>	Forecast to move <b>North Northwest</b> at <b>11 kph</b> .
<b>Forecast Positions</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>24 Hour (Tomorrow morning): 450 km East of Borongan City, Eastern Samar (12.3°N, 129.5°E)</li> <li>48 Hour (Tuesday morning): 690 km East Northeast of Borongan City, Eastern Samar (14.4°N, 131.1°E)</li> <li>72 Hour (Wednesday morning): 905 km East Northeast of Borongan City, Eastern Samar (14.8°N, 133.1°E)</li> <li>96 Hour (Thursday morning): 1,065 km East Northeast of Borongan City, Eastern Samar (14.0°N, 134.9°E)</li> </ul>

## II. ACTIONS TAKEN

- NDRRM Operations Center disseminated **Severe Weather Bulletin No. 05 for Tropical Depression “BISING”** to all OCD Regional Offices through SMS and facsimile and uploaded on the NDRRMC website for further dissemination to their respective local DRRMCs from the provincial down to the municipal levels.
  - Directed RDRRMCs concerned through the OCD Regional Offices to undertake precautionary measures in their areas of responsibility (AOR) and subsequently advised local DRRMCs to initiate pre-emptive evacuation of families in low-lying areas and mountainous areas if situations warrants.
