
I. SITUATION OVERVIEW:

The Tail-End of a Cold Front will bring cloudy skies with moderate to occasionally heavy rains and thunderstorms over the provinces of Samar, Leyte and Bohol. Residents in these areas are alerted against possible flashfloods and landslides.

Meanwhile, Bicol Region and the rest of Visayas will experience cloudy skies with light to moderate rains and thunderstorms.

You are directed to continuously monitor situation and undertake precautionary measures in your area of responsibility (AOR). Likewise, the public and the DRRMCs are advised to take appropriate actions, as necessary.
