I. SITUATION OVERVIEW:

The effect of Tail-End of a Cold Front has weakened. However, Eastern Visayas and the Provinces of Surigao del Norte and Dinagat Island will continue to have cloudy skies with light to moderate rains and thunderstorms.

With this development, this is the Final Advisory for the weather system.

II. ACTIONS TAKEN

- NDRRM Operations Center disseminated Weather Advisory No. 01 for Tail-End of a Cold Front (TECF) to all OCD Regional Offices I, II, III, IV-A (CALABARZON), IV-B (MIMAROPA), V, VI, VII, VIII, IX, X, XI, XII, XIII (CARAGA), Cordillera Administrative Region (CAR), National Capital Region (NCR), Negros Island Region (NIR), and Autonomous Region in Muslim Mindanao (ARMM) through SMS and facsimile and uploaded on the NDRRMC website for further dissemination to their respective local DRRMCs from the provincial down to the municipal levels.
 - Directed RDRRMCs concerned through the OCD Regional Offices to continuously monitor and undertake precautionary measures in their areas of responsibility (AOR) and subsequently advised local DRRMCs to initiate pre-emptive evacuation of families in low-lying areas and mountainous areas, if situations warrants.
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
