## **NDRRMC UPDATE**

in Regions IX, X, XII, and ARMM**

### **A. Situation Overview:**

#### **09 March 2017**

The Tail-End of a Cold Front brought cloudy skies with moderate to occasionally heavy rains and thunderstorms over Mindanao. Residents in these areas are alerted against possible flashfloods and landslides.

#### **10 March 2017**

The effect of Tail-End of a Cold Front has weakened. However, Eastern Visayas and the Provinces of Surigao del Norte and Dinagat Island will continue to have cloudy skies with light to moderate rains and thunderstorms.

#### **11 March 2017**

The Tail-End of a Cold Front will bring cloudy skies with moderate to occasionally heavy rains and thunderstorms over the Provinces of Samar, Leyte and Bohol. Residents in these areas are alerted against possible flashflood and landslides.

#### **12 March 2017**

The Tail-End of a Cold Front affecting Visayas and Bicol Region. Northeast Monsoon affecting Northern and Central Luzon. Cloudy skies with light to moderate rains and isolated thunderstorms is expected over Visayas and Bicol Region. Partly cloudy to cloudy skies with isolated rainshowers or thunderstorms will be experienced over Mindanao.

### **B. Effects:**

#### **1. Affected Population**

- A total of **4,354 families / 21,636 persons** were affected in the following areas in **Regions IX, X, XII, and ARMM**, out of which, **2,245 families / 11,225 persons** are staying with their relatives in **Lamitan City, Basilan and Tambulig, Zamboanga del Sur**

**C. Actions Taken:****RDRRMC IX**

- Raised alert status of Operations Center to Blue Alert starting 03 March 2017

**PDRRMC Lanao del Norte**

- WASAR Team rescued trapped families due to flooding
- Conducted clearing operations along National Highway, Tanguetiron, Tubod, Lanao del Norte

**PDRRMC Misamis Occidental**

- Placed Search and Rescue Team on standby for possible deployment
- On continuous monitoring

**MDRRMC Bonifacio, Misamis Occidental**

- Provided food and medical assistance to the evacuees

**MDRRMC Don Victoriano, Misamis Occidental**

- Conducted river status monitoring and community warning

**MDRRMC Tubod, Lanao del Norte**

- Conducted Pre-Disaster Risk Assessment with MDRRMC TWG on 07 March 2017
- Activated Emergency Operations Center and Incident Command System
- Implemented Camp Management procedures in Brgys. Pigcarangan and Poblacion
- Deployed Rescue Groups in close coordination with the PDRRM Office
- Conducted clearing operation to areas experienced landslide with the Provincial Engineering Office of DPWH
- Distributed relief goods to the affected families of Brgy. Poblacion and Pigcarangan

**MDRRMC Kiamba, Sarangani**

- Conducted emergency meeting to assess the situation and facilitated the evacuation of the ten (10) affected families
- Provided hot meals to the affected families
- Search and Rescue (SAR) Group assisted in the evacuation of the affected families

**MDRRMC Maitum, Sarangani**

- Provided hot meals and food assistance to the thirty four (34) affected families
- SAR Group assisted in the evacuation of the affected families

**MDRRMO Palimbang, Sultan Kudarat**

- Issued warning information to the barangays susceptible to flooding
- Provided hot meals to the 100 affected families
- SAR Group assisted in the evacuation of the 100 affected families

**RDRRMC ARMM**

- Deployed personnel for augmentation in the Provinces of Basilan and Sulu
- Continuous monitoring and coordination re effects of TECF.

**PDRRMC Sulu**

- Conducted assessment and validation on the number of affected families due to the effects of TECF
- Conducted Emergency Meeting re the flooding incidents in their AOR.

**MDRRMC Jolo, Sulu**

- Provided hot meals, bottled water, biscuits, noodles for the families affected by flooding

**PDRRMC Basilan**

- Conducted assessment and validation on the number of affected families due to the effects of TECF
- Conducted rescue operation with AFP, PNP, and BFP for the stranded families due to flooding in Lamitan City

**Philippine Red Cross**

- Provided blankets, mats, assorted hygiene kits and clothes to affected families in Basilan
