




## NDRRMC UPDATE

### **Weather Advisory No. 01 for Low Pressure Area and Tail-End of a Cold Front**

#### **I. SITUATION OVERVIEW:**

At 10:00 AM today, a **Low Pressure Area (LPA)** has entered the Philippine Area of Responsibility (PAR) and was estimated, based on all available data in the vicinity of Sogod, Southern Leyte (10.5N, 125.0E). This weather system will bring moderate to occasionally heavy rains and thunderstorms over Visayas, Bicol region and MIMAROPA, which may trigger flashfloods and landslides. This LPA will also bring light to moderate rains over the regions of Northern Mindanao and CARAGA.

Meanwhile, the Tail-End of a Cold Front will bring to moderate occasionally heavy rains over Quezon Province, which may trigger flashfloods and landslides. This weather system will also bring light to moderate rains over Aurora and the rest of CALABARZON.

#### **II. ACTIONS TAKEN**
