I. SITUATION OVERVIEW:

The Tail-End of a Cold Front will bring moderate to occasionally heavy rains and thunderstorms over the regions of Eastern and Central Visayas and CARAGA. Residents in these areas are alerted against possible flashfloods and landslides.

Meanwhile, the rest of Visayas and rest of Mindanao will experience cloudy skies with light to moderate rains and isolated thunderstorms.

The public is advised to continuously monitor for updates to be incorporated in the 24-Hour Public Weather Forecast at 5:00 PM today, and 5:00 AM tomorrow and in the next advisory to be issued at 11:00 AM, tomorrow.

II. ACTIONS TAKEN

- NDRRM Operations Center disseminated Weather Advisory No. 01 for Low Pressure Area (LPA) to all OCD Regional Offices I, II, III, IV-A (CALABARZON), IV-B (MIMAROPA), V, VI, VII, VIII, IX, X, XI, XII, XIII (CARAGA), Cordillera Administrative Region (CAR), National Capital Region (NCR), Negros Island Region (NIR), and Autonomous Region in Muslim Mindanao (ARMM) through SMS and facsimile and uploaded on the NDRRMC website for further dissemination to their respective local DRRMCs from the provincial down to the municipal levels.
 - The public and DRRM Councils concerned are advised to continuously monitor the updates which will be incorporated in the public weather forecast at 5PM today and 5AM tomorrow. The next weather advisory will be issued at 11AM tomorrow
