I. SITUATION OVERVIEW:

- At 5:21 AM, 12 April 2017, a moderate earthquake of magnitude 6.0 shook the island of Mindanao. The epicenter is located 13 km northwest of Wao, Lanao del Sur at a depth of 1 km. The earthquake was generated by the movement of a northwest trending active fault in the area.
- Small-magnitude earthquakes followed afterwards, and as of 6:00 AM of 14 April 2017, 314 aftershocks have been recorded by PHIVOLCS seismic monitoring network.
- The following are the reported intensities and instrumental intensities:

II. EFFECTS:

A. AFFECTED POPULATION

 To date, a total of <u>984 families / 4,404 families were affected</u> in the Provinces of Lanao del Sur and Bukidnon. Of which, 777 families / 3,501 persons were affected in thirteen (13) barangays in Wao, Lanao del Sur and 207 families / 903 persons affected in eight (8) barangays in Kalilangan, Bukidnon:

a. At 5:21 AM, 12 April 2017, power and water supply in the municipality was interrupted. Power supply returned at 3:00 PM and water supply resumed at 12:00 NN, both of the same day.

F. DECLARATION OF STATE OF CALAMITY

The MDRRMC-Wao have declared state of calamity through Sanggunian Bayan Resolution No. 20 signed on 17 April 2017.

III. DISASTER RESPONSE

A. NATIONAL

1. National DRRM Operations Center (NDRRMOC)

a. Immediately disseminated the earthquake information to OCDRO ARMM and other concerned stakeholders through facsimile, SMS, website and twitter account for further dissemination to their respective local DRRMCs. Moreover, advised them to undertake precautionary measures and to monitor the situation for any possible effects of said earthquake particularly in areas with reported intensities.

2. DOST-Philippine Institute of Volcanology and Seismology (PHIVOLCS)

- a. Disseminated Earthquake Information No. 01, 02, 03, and 04 and is closely monitoring the situation and any new significant development will be immediately relayed to all concerned.
- b. Conducted an assessment on the affected areas in Wao and Amai Manabilang together with DOST-PHIVOLCS Cotabato Seismic Station.

3. Department of Social Welfare and Development (DSWD)

- a. DSWD-DROMIC is coordinating with DSWD Field Office (FO) X, XI, and XII
 for updates on the extent of damages and number of affected families in their
 areas of responsibility.
- b. DSWD Central Office, and FOs X, XI, and XII have a total stockpile and standby funds amounting ₱1,204,953.38, with breakdown as follows:

Stockpiles

A total of 114,319 Family Food Packs (FFPs) worth ₱54,932,289.55 and Food and Non-Food Items (NFIs) worth ₱93,598,483.83.

Standby Funds

A total of ₱1,204,134,953.38 standby funds are available at the Central Office and Field Offices. Of which, ₱1,006,928,394.10 is the Quick Response Fund.

- DSWD Central Office thru DSWD XII provided 200 FFPs to the affected families.
- d. DSWD Disaster Response Assistance and Management Bureau (DREAMB) organized a Mission Team scheduled for a flight to Cotabato City on 18 April 2017 to bring augmentation relief items intended for the affected families.

4. Department of Public Works and Highways (DPWH)

a. Coordinated with DPWH Regional Offices to check the status of public buildings and national roads/bridges in their area of responsibilities.

B. REGIONAL

1. REGION X

OCD X

 a. OCD-RDRRMC X coordinated with Local DRRM Council and DOST-PHIVOLCS regarding the earthquake incident.

DOH X

- a. Deployed response teams composed of three (3) Nurses, two (2) Engineers and three (3) Drivers to conduct Rapid Health Assessment
- b. Augmented fifty (50) folding beds, fifteen (15) tents, and twenty (20) Jerry cans amounting to ₱271, 200.00.

PDRRMC Bukidnon

- a. Provided generator set to MDRRMC Kalilangan.
- b. Conducting assessment on damaged infrastructures.
- c. Coordinating with 403rd Bde, Philippine Army for use of tents intended for the patients at Bukidnon Provincial Hospital-Kalilangan.

MDRRMO Kalilangan

a. Personnel from Kalilangan Municipal Engineers Office, MDRRMO Rescue, and DPWH conducted an initial assessment in the municipality.

2. RDRRMC ARMM

OCD ARMM

- a. Coordinated with Local DRRM Council and DOST-PHIVOLCS regarding the earthquake incident.
- Provided the following Non-Food Items for the affected families in the Municipality of Wao:
 - 300 pcs of plastic pails
 - 100 pcs of Sakoline
 - 250 pcs of Water Containers
 - 2 Emergency Tents
 - · 300 pcs of 1 liter bottled water
 - 300 pcs of plastic dipper

ARMM-Humanitarian Emergency Action and Response Team (ARMM HEART)

 Deployed personnel to assist in the conduct of damage assessment in the Municipalities of Wao and Amai Manabilang.

DOH ARMM

a. Augmented tents for the patients in Wao District Hospital and provided jerry cans and water purifying tabs.

PDRRMC Lanao del Sur

a. Augmented 2,000 packs or relief assistance (3 kilos of rice, 3 pcs of canned goods, 3 pcs instant noodles, 12 pcs instant coffee, and 1 kilo of sugar).

MDRRMC Wao

- a. Organized Rapid Damage Assessment and Needs Analysis (RDANA) Team composed of personnel from Municipal Engineering Office, PNP, AFP, Municipal Social Welfare and Development Office, Rural Health Unit, BFP, and MDRRMO.
- Recommended to the Sangguniang Bayan of Wao to declare a State of Calamity per MDRRMC Resolution No. 3, series of 2017 dated 13 April 2017.
- c. Provided 499 packs of relief goods for Brgys. West Kili-kili, East Kili-kili, Panang, Serran Village, and Extension.

3. RDRRMC XI

DSWD XI

 a. DSWD Field Office XI submitted Terminal Report indicating that there was neither reported damaged nor affected families in this incident

4. RDRRMC XII

DSWD

 a. DSWD Field Office XII is in close coordination with MSWDO and MDRRMO of Wao for further assistance needed

IV. COST OF ASSISTANCE

To date, a total of \$\mathbb{P}500,176.40\$ worth of assistance has been provided to the affected families in Wao, Lanao del Sur. Of which \$\mathbb{P}252,394.40\$ was provided by the DSWD, while \$\mathbb{P}247,782.00\$ was provided by the LGU of Wao.
