I. SITUATION OVERVIEW

"CRISING" IS ABOUT TO MAKE LANDFALL OVER HERNANI, EASTERN SAMAR.

- Estimated rainfall amount is from moderate to occasionally heavy within the **150 km** diameter of the Tropical Depression.
- Residents in areas under Tropical Cyclone Warning Signal (TCWS) 1 are alerted against possible flashfloods and landslides.
- **Tropical Cyclone Warning Signals elsewhere are now lifted.**

Location of Eye/Center	At 4:00 PM today, the center of Tropical Depression (TD) "CRISING" was estimated based on all available data at 50 km East Southeast of Borongan City, Eastern Samar (11.4°N, 125.8°E) .			
Strength	Maximum winds of up to 45 kph near the center and gustiness of up to 62 kph .			
Forecast Movement	Forecast to move West Northwest at 17 kph .
