I. SITUATION OVERVIEW

"CRISING" IS ABOUT TO MAKE LANDFALL OVER HERNANI, EASTERN SAMAR.

<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Estimated rainfall amount is from moderate to occasionally heavy within the 150 km diameter of the Tropical Depression. Residents in areas under Tropical Cyclone Warning Signal (TCWS) 1 are alerted against possible flashfloods and landslides. Tropical Cyclone Warning Signals elsewhere are now lifted. 				
Location of Eye/Center		At 4:00 PM today, the center of Tropical Depression (TD) "CRISING" was estimated based on all available data at 50 km East Southeast of Borongan City, Eastern Samar (11.4°N, 125.8°E) .		
Strength		Maximum winds of up to 45 kph near the center and gustiness of up to 62 kph .		
Forecast Movement		Forecast to move West Northwest at 17 kph .

Some banana plants are tilted, a few downed and leaves are generally damaged. Twigs of small trees may be broken. Rice crops, however, may suffer significant damage when it is in its flowering stage.

Wave Height: (Open Sea) 1.25 – 4.0 meters

II. ACTIONS TAKEN

- NDRRM Operations Center disseminated **Severe Weather Bulletin No. 9 for Tropical Depression "CRISING"** to all OCD Regional Offices through SMS and facsimile and uploaded on the NDRRMC website for further dissemination to their respective local DRRMCs from the provincial down to the municipal levels.
- Directed RDRRMCs concerned through the OCD Regional Offices to undertake precautionary measures in their areas of responsibility (AOR) and subsequently advised local DRRMCs to initiate pre-emptive evacuation of families in low-lying areas and mountainous areas if situations warrants.
- Concerned Regional and Local DRRMCs are directed to undertake the necessary preparedness measures and possible response actions.
