I. SITUATION OVERVIEW

TROPICAL DEPRESSION CRISING HAS SLIGHTLY SLOWED DOWN WHILE MOVING WEST-NORTHWEST

| Location of Eye/Center | At 10:00 PM today, the center of Tropical Depression (TD) "CRISING" was estimated based on all available data at 310 km East of Guiuan, Eastern Samar (10.6°N, 128.5°E) . |
| Strength | Maximum winds of up to 45 kph near the center and gustiness of up to 55 kph . |
| Forecast Movement | Forecast to move West Northwest at 20 kph |

II. ACTIONS TAKEN

- NDRRM Operations Center disseminated **Severe Weather Bulletin No. 3 for Tropical Depression “CRISING”** to all OCD Regional Offices through SMS and facsimile and uploaded on the NDRRMC website for further dissemination to their respective local DRRMCs from the provincial down to the municipal levels.
- Directed RDRRMCs concerned through the OCD Regional Offices to undertake precautionary measures in their areas of responsibility (AOR) and subsequently advised local DRRMCs to initiate pre-emptive evacuation of families in low-lying areas and mountainous areas if situations warrants.
