#### I. SITUATION OVERVIEW

**"CRISING" HAS SLIGHTLY INTENSIFIED AS IT MOVES CLOSER TO SAMAR PROVINCES.**

	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Estimated rainfall amount is from moderate to occasionally heavy within the 250 km diameter of the Tropical Depression.</li><li>• Expected to make landfall over Samar island this afternoon.</li><li>• Residents in areas under Tropical Cyclone Warning Signal (TCWS) 1 are alerted against possible flashfloods and landslides.</li><li>• Possible inclusion of Camarines Norte, Marinduque and <b>Mindoro Provinces</b> under TCWS 1 in the next bulletin.</li></ul>
<b>Location of Eye/Center</b>	At <b>4:00 AM</b> today, the center of Tropical Depression (TD) "CRISING" was estimated based on all available data at <b>220 km East of Guiuan, Eastern Samar (10.9°N, 127.7°E)</b> .
<b>Strength</b>	Maximum winds of up to <b>55 kph</b> near the center and gustiness of up to <b>68 kph</b> .
<b>Forecast Movement</b>	Forecast to move <b>West Northwest</b> at <b>22 kph</b>
<b>Forecast Positions</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• <b>24 Hour (Tomorrow morning): 70 km West of Masbate City, Masbate (12.3°N, 123.0°E)</b></li><li>• <b>48 Hour (Monday morning): 200 km Northwest of Coron, Palawan (13.1°N, 118.8°E)</b></li><li>• <b>72 Hour (Tuesday morning): 310 km West Southwest of Iba, Zambales (14.6°N, 117.2°E)</b></li><li>• <b>96 Hour (Wednesday morning): 340 km West Northwest of Iba, Zambales (16.3°N, 117.0°E)</b></li></ul>

## II. ACTIONS TAKEN

- NDRRM Operations Center disseminated **Severe Weather Bulletin No. 5 for Tropical Depression “CRISING”** to all OCD Regional Offices through SMS and facsimile and uploaded on the NDRRMC website for further dissemination to their respective local DRRMCs from the provincial down to the municipal levels.
- Directed RDRRMCs concerned through the OCD Regional Offices to undertake precautionary measures in their areas of responsibility (AOR) and subsequently advised local DRRMCs to initiate pre-emptive evacuation of families in low-lying areas and mountainous areas if situations warrants.
