I. SITUATION OVERVIEW

The Tropical Depression (TD) East of Southern Luzon has intensified into a Tropical Storm (TS), and entered the Philippine Area of Responsibility (PAR) and was named "DANTE".

	<ul style="list-style-type: none">Estimated rainfall amount is from moderate to heavy within the 300 km diameter of the Tropical Storm (TS).
Location of Eye/Center	At 10:00 AM today, the center of Tropical Storm (TS) "DANTE" was estimated based on all available data at 1,170 km East Virac, Catanduanes (13.5°N, 135.0°E) .
Strength	Maximum sustained winds of up to 65 kph near the center and gustiness of up to 80 kph .
Forecast Movement	Forecast to move Northwest at 11 kph
Forecast Positions	<ul style="list-style-type: none">24 Hour (Tomorrow morning): 1,165 km East of Casiguran, Aurora (15.0°N, 132.9°E)48 Hour (Friday morning): 1,445 km East of Aparri, Cagayan (Outside PAR) (17.2°N, 135.2°E)72 Hour (Saturday morning): 1,740 km East of Basco, Batanes (Outside PAR) (19.8°N, 138.6°E)
