I. SITUATION OVERVIEW

"DANTE" has weakened into a Tropical Depression and is now outside the Philippine Area of Responsibility (PAR).

• Estimated rainfall amount is from moderate to heavy within the 300 km diameter of the Tropical Depression (TD).	
Location of Eye/Center	At 10:00 PM today, the center of Tropical Depression (TD) "DANTE" was estimated based on all available data at 1,425 km East of Tuguegarao "City, Cagayan (Outside PAR) (16.9°N, 135.1°E).
Strength	Maximum sustained winds of up to 55 kph near the center and gustiness of up to 65 kph.
Forecast Movement	Forecast to move North Northeast at 18 kph
Forecast Positions	• 24 Hour (tomorrow evening): 1,730 km East of Aparri, Cagayan(19.6°N, 138.0°E)
NO TROPICAL CYCLONE WARNING SIGNAL	
With this development and unless re-entry occurs, this is the final warning for this weather disturbance.	

II. ACTIONS TAKEN
