I. SITUATION OVERVIEW

Tropical "DANTE" has maintained its strength as it continues to move North-Northwestward.

- Estimated rainfall amount is from moderate to heavy within the 300 km diameter of the Tropical Storm (TS).

Location of Eye/Center	At 10:00 PM today, the center of Tropical Storm (TS) "DANTE" was estimated based on all available data at 1,095 km East of Virac, Catanduanes (14.4°N, 134.3°E) .
Strength	Maximum sustained winds of up to 65 kph near the center and gustiness of up to 80 kph .
Forecast Movement	Forecast to move North Northwest at 13 kph
Forecast Positions	<ul style="list-style-type: none">24 Hour (Tomorrow morning): 1,355 km East of Casiguran, Aurora (17.1°N, 134.8°E)48 Hour (Friday evening): 1,695 km East of Aparri, Cagayan (Outside PAR) (19.3°N, 137.7°E)
