I. Background:

A strong distant earthquake with a preliminary magnitude of 6.6 occurred at Andreanof Islands Aleutian Islands, Alaska on 09 May 2017 at 01:01 AM (Philippine Standard Time) located at 51.4°N, 178.6°W with a depth of 02 km. No destructive Pacific-wide threat exists based on the historical and tsunami data.

This is for information purposes only and there is no tsunami threat to the Philippines from this earthquake.

II. ACTIONS TAKEN:

- NDRRMC Advisory on the earthquake information was disseminated to **OCD I, II, III, CALABARZON, MIMAROPA, V, VI, VII, VIII, IX, X, XI, XII, CARAGA, CAR, NCR, ARMM and NIR** through facsimile, SMS and website for further dissemination to their respective Local Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Councils (LDRRMCs) from the provincial down to the municipal levels.
 - DOST-PHIVOLCS is closely monitoring the situation and any new significant development will be immediately relayed to all concerned.
