I. SITUATION OVERVIEW:

At 08:00 AM today, the Low Pressure Area (LPA) embedded in the ITCZ was estimated based on all available data at 315 KM East of Surigao City (9.8°N, 128.4°E) the combined effect of LPA and ITCZ will bring moderate to occasionally heavy rains and thunderstorms over the regions of CARAGA, Northern Mindanao, Zamboanga Peninsula, and the Provinces of Southern Leyte, Bohol, Siquijor, Southern Cebu, Southern Negros Oriental, Southern Negros Occidental, and Lanao Del Sur. Residents in these areas are alerted against possible flashfloods and landslides.

Meanwhile light to moderate rains and thunderstorms will prevail over the rest of Visayas and of Mindanao.

The Public is advised to continuously monitor for updates to be incorporated in the 24-hour Public Weather Forecast to be issued at 5:00 PM today and 5:00 AM tomorrow, respectively, and in the next advisory to be issued at 11:00AM tomorrow.

You are directed to monitor the situation and undertake precautionary measures in your area of responsibility (AOR). Likewise, the public and the DRRMCs are advised to take appropriate actions, as necessary.
