I. SITUATION OVERVIEW:

At 10:00 AM today, the Low Pressure Area (LPA) was estimated based on all available data at **370 km west northwest of Iba, Zambales (16.6 °N, 116.8 °E)**. This weather system will **bring cloudy skies with light to moderate rains and thunderstorms over the provinces of Bataan, Zambales and Mindoro**. Also, the LPA is expected to develop into a tropical depression with 12-24 hours outside the Philippine Area of Responsibility (PAR).

In this development this is the final weather advisory.

The public is advised to continuously monitor for updates to be incorporated in the 24-hour Public Weather Forecast to be issued at 5:00 PM today and 5:00 AM tomorrow, and in the next advisory to be issued at 11:00 AM tomorrow.

You are directed to monitor the situation and undertake precautionary measures in your area of responsibility (AOR). Likewise, the public and the DRRMCs are advised to take appropriate actions, as necessary.
