I. SITUATION OVERVIEW:

At 10:00 AM today, the Low Pressure Area (LPA) was estimated based on all available data at **250 km West of Ambulong, Batangas (13.7 °N, 118.8 °E)**. This weather system will bring **moderate to occasionally heavy rains and thunderstorms** over **Bicol Region and the Provinces of Cavite, Batangas, Mindoro, Quezon, Aurora, and Northern Palawan**. Residents in these areas are alerted against **possible flashfloods and landslides**.

Meanwhile, Metro Manila and the rest of Luzon will have cloudy skies with light to moderate rains and thunderstorms.

The public is advised to continuously monitor for updates to be incorporated in the 24-hour Public Weather Forecast to be issued at 5:00 PM today and 5:00 AM tomorrow, and in the next advisory to be issued at 11:00 AM tomorrow.

You are directed to monitor the situation and undertake precautionary measures in your area of responsibility (AOR). Likewise, the public and the DRRMCs are advised to take appropriate actions, as necessary.
